

## RII40206 Certificate IV in Civil Construction Supervision

### Qualification Overview

Candidates who will benefit from this course are those who are currently, or are pursuing roles as foreman, site supervisors or works supervisors, being responsible for applying site work instructions and practices, to ensure the quality and quantity of the outputs of others. Candidates will be expected to perform complex and non-routine tasks involving a broad range of varied activities, and they should be able to contribute to the development of technical solutions for non-routine problems.

Upon successful completion of this course students will receive the qualification:  
RII40206 Certificate IV in Civil Construction Supervision.

### Duration

This qualification is completed within 18 months from commissioning. It is possible that following the RPL process might result in candidates completing the qualification within a shorter period.

### Entry Requirements

Nil.

CSTC recommends a candidate has a minimum of five years experience within the civil construction industry prior to undertaking this qualification.

### Delivery

The qualification will be delivered through facilitator/ trainer directed workshops, using individual activities and work based assignments to reinforce the development of underpinning knowledge.

There is approximately 7 workshops (7 days) conducted over the training period (usually 18 months). Candidates will be expected to complete all necessary assessments and assignments within this period. A variety of delivery modes may be employed for the workshops including: lectures, discussions, simulation, practical demonstration, exercises, group work and more.

Each unit of competency is supported by 'learning' guides, that include material and references to be used in the workshop, as well as instructions for the candidate's individual learning activities and work based assignments. Additional support material, instructions, activity sheets may be given to candidates as required.

The learning guides and any additional support material will contain trainee and employer instructions regarding the tasks to be undertaken and the requirements to confirm competence in the unit of competency.

Trainers will be reasonably available and accessible to candidates who may require assistance or clarification of matters at times other than the workshop.

### Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) / Credit Transfer

Candidates may be eligible to receive RPL or credit transfer depending on whether they have any previous industry experience or hold existing qualifications. Applicants should speak with CSTC at the time of sign-up to discuss these options further.

### Fees & Charges

Current fees and charges associated with this qualification will be provided to prospective candidates and/ or their employers upon their initial enquiry. Funding may also be available to eligible applicants.
