

## **RII10106 Certificate I in Resources & Infrastructure Operations**

### **Qualification Overview**

This is a pre-vocational qualification designed to provide students with an insight into the civil construction industry and make them “job ready” for any potential employers. Upon successful completion of this qualification students will be awarded RII10106 Certificate I in Resources & Infrastructure Operations.

### **Duration**

This qualification can be delivered full-time OR part-time over 200 nominal hours.

### **Entry Requirements**

To be eligible to apply for this qualification applicants must be enrolled in Years 10, 11 or 12 or be at least 15 years of age.

### **Delivery**

This qualification is delivered via a combination of several on and off the job training opportunities. *(N.B. If a workplace for the on the job training component is not available, then a simulated workplace environment is provided).* An engagement policy and contract detailing the training dates and associated units of competency will be provided at the time of sign-up.

### **Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) / Credit Transfer**

Prospective students may be eligible to receive RPL or credit transfer depending on whether they have any previous industry experience or hold existing qualifications. Applicants should speak with CSTC at the time of sign-up to discuss these options further.

### **Fees & Charges**

Current fees and charges associated with this qualification will be provided to prospective students upon their initial enquiry. *(N.B. Some fee exemptions apply).*

### **Refund Policy**

The Refund Policy confirms that refunds are provided (as appropriate) within an acceptable time frame. In all instances, a full refund of enrolment fees will be made to the payer if training is cancelled by CSTC for any reason.
